...**praise all players** for participating, regardless of their athletic skills.

...**remain calm** when players and/or officials make mistakes.

...**remind all players not to get down** on themselves when things do not go well

...**try not to take myself too seriously** when it comes to my involvement in youth sports, reminding myself that youth sports are for children, not adults.

...**emphasize teamwork** in team sports with the players, teaching them to think “we”.

...**is to ensure all parents are aware of the policy and expected conduct. Forms available from each association.**

Unacceptable Behavior

- Physical violence or threats
- Obscene, vulgar, threatening language or gestures
- Taunting of players, coaches, officials or other spectators
- Throwing of objects
- Damaging recreational facility

First Violation

- A meeting with the individual and advise of the compliance with the Policy.

Second Violation

- The individual must leave the City recreational facility.
- The individual shall not return until his/her appropriate action has been discussed.
- A disposition will be signed by all parties.

Third Violation

- The individual will be banned from attending all league activities held at City of Moncton facilities.
