- I will remain calm when players make a mistake, and help them learn from their mistakes.
- I will remind all players not to get down on themselves when things do not go well.
- I will try not to take myself too seriously when it comes to my involvement in youth sports, reminding myself that youth sports are for children, not adults.
- I will remind myself and all players to laugh and keep a sense of humour.
- I will emphasize teamwork in team sports with the players, teaching them to think "we" instead of "me."

It is imperative that parents/spectators conduct themselves in a proper manner. Use of profanity, verbal, or physical harassment towards officials, staff, coaches, or players, will not be permitted. I understand that failure to abide by the policy and the above code of conduct will result in the following: First offence: parents/spectators being asked by a league representative to stop the inappropriate behaviour; Second offence: parents/spectator being ejected from the game; Third offence: parents/spectators being banned from all league activities. I also understand that physical violence or threats of physical violence will result in an immediate and permanent ban from all league activities.
